### Observation Questions:

#### WHAT DO I SEE?

- 1) **READ** 1 Peter 1:22-2:3. As you read, **OBSERVE** and write down anything that stands out to you. As with last week, this can be themes, repeated words of significance, references to God, etc. But also, look for references back to ideas from previous passages in 1 Peter. Be ready to share these observations with your group.
- 2) **QUESTION?** What questions do you have about this passage?

#### WHAT DOES IT SAY?

- 3) What does the passage say about the following words and phrases (be ready to share with your group):
  - a) purified soul/pure heart
  - b) born again
  - c) word of God
  - d) malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy and slander
  - e) baby/milk
  - f) Any other words or phrases of interest

### Interpretation Questions:

#### WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- 4) How and to what are we purified?
- 5) What is the nature of Christ like love?
- 6) How is being born again and the Word of God the power for Christ like love?
- 7) What does Peter mean in 2:1 when he tells us to, "Put away all...?"
- 8) What is pure spiritual milk and how does it help us to achieve Christ like love?
- 9) **MAIN POINT** - Based on the passage, pastor Johnny taught that the universal truth (main point for all time) is, "If the Gospel is embraced by God's people, the gospel will be displayed by God's people." What does he mean and how does this passage support this?

### Application Questions:

#### WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO ME?

- 10) Looking back at question 7, how can we "put away" malice and slander? Be specific.
- 11) Pick a psalm for the week. Read it, meditate on it and memorize it. Then, be ready to share it with your study or someone at church next Sunday.
