Do you desire to love life & see good days?

Be a blessing & receive a blessing. vv. 10-13

- Speak love & truth.
- Spurn evil & do good.
- Soak up the Lord's attentive provisions.
- Skip unnecessary suffering.

Be sure in suffering. vv. 14, 16-17

- Assume suffering.
- Assume a blessing.
- Assume suffering for doing good is doing God's will.

Be prepared to share. v. 15

- Dedicate your heart to Christ above all.
- Demonstrate your hope.
- Discuss the reason for your hope.
