Observation Questions:

Be ready to share these observations with your group.
- 2) **QUESTION?** What questions do you have about this passage?

- 3) What does the passage say about the following words and phrases (be ready to share with your group):
 - a) What is the purpose of the term "likewise" in vs. 1 and 7
 - b) Submit
 - c) Be won
 - d) Adorning
 - e) Live with
 - f) honor
- 4) List all of the things wives are called to do in the passage. Now list all of the things husbands are called to do.
- 5) What else did you notice in the passage?

Interpretation Questions:

- 6) In what way is Christ an example of submission?
- 7) What does Peter NOT mean when he tells wives to, "Be subject to"?
- 8) In what way is submission an 'ORDER about order'?
- 9) In what way is submission an OPPORTUNITY?
- 10) In what way is submission an ORNAMENT?
- 11) In vs. 7 husbands are called to "honor" their wives. Based on the text what are husbands being called to do?

Application Questions:

- 12) **MAIN POINT** - Based on the passage, pastor Justin taught that, "Wives are to be subject to their husbands and that husbands are to honor their wives?"
 - a) What does this look like in your marriage?
